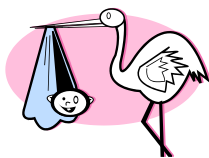

## BLUESTONE IN BLOOM with Sophie Thomson

Resident family and friends attended Sophie's Spring workshop on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> September. Sophie's tips for Spring planting are:-

1. Use a seaweed plant tonic to support the young root system as it becomes established.
2. Use a drought shield for young plants as it helps guard against the harsh extremes of Spring – cold frosty mornings and harsh windy heat.
3. Mulch the garden with pea straw or bark based products to reduce the need to water, insulate the soil and suppress weeds and weed seed germination.
